VENTILATION	Enforcement of ventilation protocols. <i>(Minimum of 15 minutes ventilation in the morning before the children arrive, in between each class, during lunchtime and during the evening cleaning).</i>				
HYGIENE	Tissues, hand gel and bins will be provided in each classroom and handwashing protocols will be maintained, using either soap and water or hand gel. (Upon arrival at KidooLand, when changing rooms, before and after eating, before and after using the toilets, after sneezing/blowing nose, after having used communal equipment; upon returning from an outing and before leaving KidooLand).				
CLEANING	once per day.	Cleaning protocol for frequently touched surfaces... multiple times per day.			
	Dining tables to be cleaned after each child.				
	Standard equipment cleaning protocols.	Disinfection or quarantine (24h) of equipment used at the end of each class.			
CANTEEN	No social distancing for maternelle & primary aged children. 2m spacing for secondary children mandatory.	No obligatory social distancing for maternelle children but the canteen to be organised in such a way as to allow as much space as possible between children. Mandatory 2m social distancing for all primary and secondary school children.			
ACTIVITIES	No restrictions.	INDOORS & OUTDOORS: Physical and sports activities authorised indoors & outdoors, but they must respect 2m social distancing and mask wearing as appropriate.	OUTDOORS : Physical and sports activities authorised but must respect 2m social distancing and mask wearing rules. INDOORS: 'Low-intensity' indoor activities with masks kept on as appropriate are authorised.	OUTDOORS : Physical and sports activities authorised but must respect 2m social distancing and mask wearing rules. INDOORS: No physical or sports activities are allowed.
